## Penn Township Regular Meeting December 13, 2021

Fitzsimons called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m Oli was absent.

Leach presented the minutes from the prior meeting, as prepared by Fitzsimons. Leach moved to approve the minutes. Sparks seconded and motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Rutherford. Leach moved to approve the report. Sparks seconded and motion passed.

The board remembered Billie Jo Meggs and William Burrows.

The Jeffries Street culvert repair is complete. The cost was approximately \$65,000 which was considerably less than the proposed bridge. We will use the first Covid relief payment toward this expenditure.

Mary Deneau is reviewing potential water and sewer funding to address potential issues with our water quality. We do have sediment build up in our water. Oli spoke with Dowagiac DPW regarding updates to the system to improve quality. Dowagiac is currently working with Deneau on this project.

The refinancing of the water system debt is entering the final stages. Fitzsimons moved to approve the resolution approving the refund contract. This will allow Oli and Fitzsimons to approve the contract. Leach seconded and motion passed by unanimous roll call vote (Oli absent).

Bill Schuld has inquired regarding sewer connections to parcels on the north side of Donnell Lake for a spec home. Oli has discussed sewer service with Kevin. Kevin suggested that we extend the system and require connection by the existing property owners. CAUA could pay for engineering fees in order to determine a plan. Deneau has two proposed options for this extension. The options will be reviewed at January meeting after details are received. It has been proposed to run the line all the way to M-60. Sewer connection financing will be discussed.

The Covid Relief funding application was approved. We could receive up to \$150,000 of funding. We received the first installment of \$75,204.50 on November 10<sup>th</sup>.

The cell tower construction has not begun and we don't have any idea when this will happen. Oli would like us to consider a 90-day deadline. We will table this again until next month and determine if any progress has been made. The lessee did record the intended lease with the County. Oli will follow up.

The White Temple road landfill was discussed. It is owned by an authority of 6 municipalities including Penn Township. No hunting leases will be allowed due to liability and tax exempt issues. There are also potential environmental concerns. The authority is defunct. The property will be inspected. We will explore getting clean title to the property.

A marijuana processing plant is being proposed for the former Bullseye Market building. Common Citizens,, a marijuana operation out of Marshall, is pursuing this option for that building.

Rutherford and Oli met with the Road Commission regarding future projects.

Penn Township is seeking to hire an Election Coordinator for 2022 elections.

Utility hearing information is available.

Various legislative updates and communication were discussed.

The Fire Department report was provided by Bogue. They are planning a new driveway for the Fire Dept. The current asphalt is insufficient to support the newer heavier equipment. This will be planned for Spring 2022.

No CAUA report was available.

No ambulance report was available.

No County Commissioner report was available.

No assessing report was available. December BOR will be December 15th at 5:00 p.m.

Leach provided a zoning report. The Sampson property in Penn was discussed. They have made a dent in the junk on the property, so we will continue to give them additional time. We will inspect the property again next month. Leach addressed issues at the home on the corner of Quaker and White Temple. They have begun some clean up. We could consider a zoning change to address unlicensed vehicles.

The bills were presented for payment. Check numbers 22138-22174 for a total of \$25,920.02 will be disbursed. Rutherford moved to approve the bills for payment. Leach seconded and motion passed by unanimous roll call vote (Oli absent).

The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
