Penn Township Regular Meeting May 10, 2021

Oli called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All members were present.

Leach presented the minutes from the prior meeting, as prepared by Fitzsimons. Leach moved to approve the minutes. Sparks seconded and motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Rutherford. Sparks moved to approve the report. Leach seconded and motion passed.

Beth Pompey provided the Ambulance report.

The MEC grant has entered the second approval phase.

The Jeffries drainage application has been submitted.

Tom Sheetz pulled a water permit for a home on Lewis Lake. Dowagiac now owes us for two connection fees. Dowagiac has indicated the money is forthcoming.

We are reviewing banking options for higher interest since Circle lowered our rate substantially.

Paul recommends that we do nothing about the deed to the Hall. We found that the deed was not in our name when we were working on the cell tower agreement. The cell tower company will fund the deed correction if their attorneys require any action.

Oli and Leach discussed potential changes to the zoning ordinance. They will research and then recommend proposed changes for our consideration.

We have received additional inquiries regarding marijuana licenses. Oli moved to approve the addition of marijuana microbusiness licensing to the zoning ordinance. Leach seconded and motion passed.

Mary Deneau is reviewing potential water and sewer funding to address potential issues with our water quality. We do have sediment build up in our water. Oli spoke with Dowagiac DPW regarding updates to the system to improve quality. Dowagiac is currently working with Deneau on this project. They are proposing a synchronized hydrant flushing. Dowagiac, Oli and Jim will coordinate the flushing schedule to determine if Penn Fire Dept. can accommodate the plan.

Oli moved to approve the Cass County Board of Public Works Operation and Management Agreement with the City of Dowagiac for a period of 10 years. Fitzsimons seconded and motion passed.

Dust control marking will take place June 4th We are proposing to raise the Diamond Island fee since the cost is so much higher for the Island. Oli will contact Bob Price.

Bobby Leonard has applied for a variance for an encroachment on Shore Acres Drive. This hearing will be held in May.

Oli moved to approve the debt refunding contract between Cass County and Penn Township for our special assessment funds. Sparks seconded and motion passed.

We are seeking recommendations for new Zoning Board of Appeals members. Oli moved to appoint Agust Olafsson to the Board. Leach seconded and motion passed. We are still seeking additional members.

Rutherford moved to raise the variance fee to \$600. Fitzsimons seconded and motion passed.

MEC has contacted us regarding fiber optic internet for the Hall and Fire Dept. Oli will follow up with MEC regarding a phone line.

Fitzsimons moved to adopt the Donnell Lake Special Assessment Resolution relative to weed control which establishes the district and provides notice of the public hearing to be held on June 14th at 7:00 p.m. Leach seconded and motion passed.

Hall rentals are currently being prohibited due to the Covid- 19 pandemic. We will address future hall rentals in June.

Utility hearing information is available.

Various legislative updates and communication were discussed.

The Fire Department report was provided by Bogue.

McGrew provided a CAUA report.

No County Commissioner report was available.

McGrew provided an assessing report.

Leach provided a zoning report.

Cass County is hosting a tire collection and hazardous waste collection day on May 15^{th} 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. at the CCRC.

The bills were presented for payment. Check numbers 21896-21929 for a total of \$25,406.81 will be disbursed. Leach moved to approve the bills for payment. Sparks seconded and motion passed by unanimous roll call vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:34 p.m.
