The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

VIII. Instructions for Completing Application

Total Fee: (must include \$75.00 non-refundable application fee and \$75.00 inspection fee. Also, must include the number of inspections required by the plumbing code

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number. Schedule permitting, an inspector will respond to an inspection request within 2 business days to schedule the inspection. The inspector will typically perform the inspection within 5 business days as his or her schedule permitts.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO RE-OPEN A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$75.00.
