### Penn Township Regular Meeting June 13, 2022

Oli called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All members were present.

Leach presented the minutes from the prior meeting, as prepared by Fitzsimons. Sparks moved to approve the minutes. Leach seconded and motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Rutherford. Leach moved to approve the report. Sparks seconded and motion passed.

Scott McGraw, candidate for State House representative, was present to introduce himself.

Mike Guinane, from the Diamond Lake Association, was present to introduce himself and invite public officials to Appreciation Day on August 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Jason provided the ambulance report.

Penn residents were present to complain about conditions in Penn. We explained our actions to date in Penn. We will continue to pursue cleaning up the area. Roger made a note of properties discussed and will follow up.

Nippers Greenhouse donated two begonia baskets to Penn Township. The Board thanked them for the donation.

Fitzsimons moved to appoint Patricia Mitchell as Deputy Clerk. Leach seconded and motion passed.

MEC has indicated that internet service will be active at Penn by the end of July.

Oli moved to approve the contract with JC Fencing for \$18,680. Fitzsimons seconded and motion passed by unanimous roll call vote.

Decatur, Geneva and Penn Road contracts were presented for approval. Total cost is approximately \$153,000. Oli moved to approve the contracts. Rutherford seconded and motion passed by unanimous roll call vote.

The new tennis and pickle ball courts will be ready by the end of July.

We need to amend the budget as follows: Marijuana License revenue up to \$355,000, Hall Capital Outlay to \$225,000, Roads to \$168,000 and Fire Grant income to \$7,500. Fitzsimons moved to approve the budget amendments. Leach seconded. Motion passed by unanimous roll call vote.

We have a new plan for the money budgeted for the asphalt repairs at the Fire Dept. We would like to just repair the ruts for now and set aside the remainder of money for a new building. Oli will contact road commission regarding rut repair. We will adjust budget again once we know the figures.

The remaining DARPA money has been authorized and will be released soon.

The Lippert property on Diamond Lake was granted a temporary septic holding tank while the sewer is connected. The sewer must be connected by 12/1.

Inquiries and complaints regarding weed treatment at Donnell Lake have been discussed with Progressive AE. Communication improvement to lake property owners has been requested.

The Election Commission will meet on July 11th at 6:15 p.m.

Security cameras were discussed. We have decided to not pursue this at this time.

Utility hearing information is available.

Various legislative updates and communication were discussed.

The Fire Department report was provided by Bogue.

No CAUA report was available.

No County Commissioner report was available.

Rich McGrew provided an assessing report.

Leach provided a zoning report. Mr. Sampson has made progress cleaning up his property. We will continue to monitor the situation.

The bills were presented for payment. Check numbers 22316-22346 for a total of \$35,533.37 will be disbursed. Check # 22386 will be issued to JC Fencing in the amount of \$18,680.00. Sparks moved to approve the bills for payment. Leach seconded and motion passed by unanimous roll call vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
